FINE ARTS – GRAPHICS

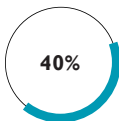

The admission is based on an interview that aims to test basic aptitudes required by the pedagogical profession.



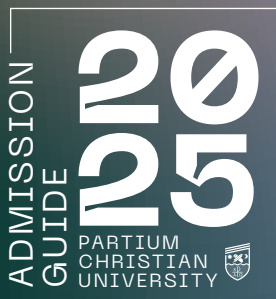
