# I. History and Mission of the Partium Christian University



The Romanian Parliament granted the Sulyok István Reformed College, founded on 19 May 1990, the institutional accreditation as the Partium Christian University after 18 years, on 21 October 2008. It was the first state-recognised Hungarian higher education institution of the Transylvanian Hungarians in Partium as an independent legal entity with private status and public benefit.

Our University aims to implement the following principles and aspects:

- the promotion of Christian and universal human values;
- to provide professional training and continuing education to meet the needs of the Partium region;
- preserving and strengthening the identity of our national community;
- ensuring competitive, high-quality education and research;
- transparent, consistent management of the university,

### VII. University Booklet

#### **Enrolment contract**

- you must sign a contract with the University at the faculty secretary's office after you have been successfully admitted;
- sets out the general rights and obligations of the University and the student;
- is for the entire duration of your studies at university.

#### Study contract

- must be signed annualyly in the first week of the academic year at the faculty secretary's office;
- contains a list of compulsory, compulsory (optional) and optional (elective) subjects to be completed during the academic year. Student card
- you can pick it up at the beginning of the academic year at the faculty secretary's office;
- to prove that you are a

student of the Partium Christian University, where this is required (e.g. public transport, museum, theatre).

Teacher in charge of the class

- the university equivalent of the homeroom teacher;
- if you have questions, difficulties or problems with your studies, ask him/ her for help first.

Student in charge of the class (or group)

- the university equivalent of the class monitor;
- you and your classmates choose this person together:
- represents the year class or group in academic matters.

#### **Timetable**

- you will receive it by e-mail;
- as the timetable may be subject to some changes

in the first weeks of the semester, please keep a close eye on the university website.

Forms of university activities

- lecture (course): based on the theoretical knowledge of the subject;
- -seminar/practical lesson: used to deepen and apply the knowledge gained in the lecture;
- laboratory: used to demonstrate a subject in the laboratory or to practise routine elements of a subject.

Types of objects

- compulsory subjects: these provide the basic professional knowledge and must be completed during the period of study;
- compulsory (optional) subjects: designed to help students specialise and deepen their knowledge of

the subject;

- optional (elective) subjects: they allow students to broaden their professional knowledge or to pursue other interests;
- general optional courses proposed by the University (Hungarian Culture and Civilisation, Introduction to the World of Religions): these serve to broaden the student's general education, and their completion is a condition for tuition fee exemption and scholarship.



#### Internships

- a compulsory subject, which enables the practical application of the knowledge acquired in a real working environment;
- depending on the subject, it takes place in the middle of the year or during the holiday period, in regular or blocked form, under the supervision of a trainer;
- can be taken in the summer, at the end of the first academic year, under Erasmus+;
- is checked with a grade.

Teacher training module
- if you also want to obtain a
teaching qualification, you
can apply for the admission
exam of the Department
for Teacher Training after
the start of the academic
year;

- you will be notified by e-mail of your admission;

the module includes one subject per semester in your normal timetable;

- the course is taken at the same time as your university studies and ends with a final exam;
- you can apply at the beginning of your second/ third year, or you can combine the three years (postgraduate).

### Course description

- the requirements for the completion of the course (aim of the course, subject, number of hours, type of sessions, number of credits, bibliography, requirements for participation in the sessions, method and conditions of verification);
- will be presented by the teacher in charge of the subject during the first lesson, and the form is available through the Venus (venus.partium.ro) system.

Academic year calendar

- contains the calendar of the academic year;
- structure:
- academic (teaching) period: 14 weeks per semester:
- Colloquium period: the last 2 weeks of the study period (some subjects have exams at this time);
- regular exam period after the semesters: 3+1 weeks, with 2 free exams per subject;
- additional exam period in autumn: 2 weeks, with 1 paid exam per subject;
- the academic year timetable can be found on the University's website, under the heading Tanévszerkezet https://wrtium.ro/hu/ egyetem/hallgatoknak/ tanevszerkezet

Forms of knowledge check - Examination: designed to

- provide a comprehensive assessment of the acquisition of knowledge and competences related to the subject;
- colloquium: a method of assessment used mainly for practical subjects;
- continuous assessment: monitoring of students' knowledge during the study period, through essays, seminar papers and evaluation of seminar/practical activities.

### Credit system (ECTS)

- each subject has a number of credits (usually between 2 and 6);
- the credit value of the subject determines how important the subject is, with more difficult subjects being worth more credits;
- by successfully completing the course, you will gain the credits assigned

to it (you will also receive the total credit value of the course with a 5 grade);

- the total number of credits for compulsory and compulsory (optional) subjects in an academic year is 60 (30+30);
- to enrol for the following year, you must have earned at least 30 credits (half of the annual number of credits) during the academic year.

#### Student mobility

- the Erasmus+/Makovecz programme can offer you a unique opportunity to gain student/professional experience in universities abroad/Hungary on a scholarship.
- follow the information provided by the Erasmus+ office and if you need encouragement, ask your fellow students to tell you

about their mobility experiences.



#### PSSC

- the Partium Scientific Student Conference is a forum for inquiring students to present their scientific results in public.
- some reasons why you should attend the PSSC:
- the difference between university life in capital letters and university life in small letters is research;
- you'll receive one-to-one mentoring, and your ideas will get the attention of teachers and students;
- public speaking can boost your self-confidence;
- can increase the effective-

ness of your studies;

- significantly increase your chances of receiving merit and study scholarships;
- excellence is rewarded with a cash prize, publication opportunities, and sometimes a place at the National Scientific Students' Conference (NSSC);
- you can prepare your final thesis in time.

### Venus system

- -through the Venus electronic system (https://venusz. partium.ro/), you can track your study status (subjects taken, grades obtained), view electronic resources related to the subact and evaluate the lecturers, find your exam timetable and pay any exam fees;
- under the Information tab you will find your Partium email address, and the office login details provided by

the university;

- you will receive your login details at the start of your studies, so you can connect from your mobile device.

#### Moodle

- a page that is also accessed by the university.
- it is used for university resources and is also widely used by teachers for online exams.

Partium-Google account

- for the duration of your studies, you will be provided with a personalised electronic account, like the G-mail package, but with several extra features.



- you can use it to correspond with the University, join a Google classroom, initiate video conferences, etc.

#### Scholarships

- as a student, you can receive several types of scholarships during your studies, based on your achievements and your social situation:
- merit scholarship (500 RON): based on outstanding research and academic achievements;
- study scholarship (400 RON, first semester 300 RON): based on your academic results and semester averages;
- social scholarship (300 RON): for students from difficult financial situations, available on application.

### Important to know:

- all scholarships are conditional on the completion of

the general optional courses (Hungarian Culture and Civilisation, Introduction to the World of Religions) proposed by the University;

- participation in and achievement at the PSSC will raise the average of the study avarage when ranking scholarship holders;
- the scholarships are paid into OTP accounts in Romania, so if you don't have one, you will need to open one.







### Library

- The library of the Partium Christian University was established in 1990. It currently offers 48 000 volumes and numerous periodicals in a free-shelf system. An electronic catalogue is available on local computers and online on the university's website under the name Huntéka
- Use of the library is free for students.

#### Tram

Public transport operated by Oradea Transport Company (OTL) provides quick and easy access to the city. The bus and tram networks cover almost the entire city and can be used almost all day (vehicles run from 05:00 to 24:00).

At rush hour, you should expect the following tracking times:

- trams: about 10 minutes:
- buses: about 12 minutes.

### Tickets and passes

Tickets can be bought at the kiosks at the stops. A single ticket costs 3 RON (available from city ticket machines) and a two-trip ticket costs 6 RON (available only at stops).

Passes can be purchased at OTL centres, with the following rates:

- monthly pass valid for all lines (with student card): 40 RON;
- day ticket: 15 RON;

weekly pass for all lines (no student discount): 40 RON;
 non-denominated monthly pass for all lines: 160 RON.

#### Buy tickets by SMS

- If you didn't manage to buy a ticket before boarding public transport, you can pay for your journey by texting 7429. The text of the message should be the line number. The price of the SMS is 0.8 € (including VAT), and the ticket is valid from the moment the message is sent until the end of the journey, but for no longer than 60 minutes.
- To buy a day ticket, send the letter L by SMS to 7429. The price is 3.5 € (including VAT). The day ticket entitles you to unlimited travel on any OTL urban public transport line for 24 hours from the date of confirmation. The ticket price will appear on your phone bill as the price of the SMS you sent to pay for the trip.
- You will receive a confirmation of your right to travel within about 15 seconds of sending the SMS, which will contain a verification code. You will have to show this code to the ticket inspector.

First aid: lay the unconscious person on their back so that their body is higher than their head to ensure that the blood supply to the head is not cut off. Check that the tongue has been swallowed. If so, it should be withdrawn from the throat by hand. Check breathing and pulse, loosen any tight clothing. If necessary, call an ambulance.

Electricity First aid:

The first thing to do is call for help and an ambulance. Do not touch the injured person! It is possible that the victim may still be in contact with the electrical power source, and you

could be injured by the contact. Switch off the power source! If this is not possible, try to remove the power source from the victim with a dry, non-conductive object (e.g. paper, plastic, wood). Check for signs of breathing, if not detectable, start CPR! After disinfecting the affected area, cover it with a sterile dressing, or if not, a clean cloth, but not a blanket or towel, as loose fibres can get stuck in the wound.

## Burning

First aid: In case of severe burns, remove clothing and shoes as a precaution. As with all burns, the most important thing to do is to cool it with cold running water for 8-10 minutes. In case of burns caused by caustic chemicals, wash the

wound immediately with

plenty of water (10-15 minutes). Call an ambulance.

Drowning

Symptoms: slowed breathing, cold hands and feet, weak heartbeat.

First aid:

Removing the person from the place where the drowning occurred.

Call an ambulance.

Lay the person on their back with their head tilted to the side.

Ensure unhindered respiratory function.

Use artificial respiration.

Poisoning

Symptoms: breathing problems, sweating, chest or abdominal pain, sickness, diarrhoea, nausea, loss of consciousness, swollen lips and burns around the mouth or on the skin. First aid:

First call an ambulance and, if necessary, the fire fighters (in case of gas poisoning). Check if the poisoned person is still conscious. In case of nauseous, turn

the patient on their side.

Fracture

Symptoms: broken bones (open or closed), dislocation of joints, tearing of tendons.

First aid:

In case of a possible fracture, call an ambulance.

Until the ambulance arrives, do not leave the injured person alone or move him/her.

Bleeding First aid:

You can stop the bleeding by applying pressure bandage or using a rubber bandage.

Remove the bandage every

15-20 minutes to ensure a minimum blood supply. In the first case, push a clean gauze directly into the wound.

In the second case, you can use a rubber band or a strap to cut off the blood supply to the area.

Make sure that the limbs are not constricted for more than one and a half hours.

Call an ambulance for the injured person or, if this is not possible, take him to hospital urgently.

Drowning First aid:

Pull the person out of the water, lay them on their back and check if they are breathing. Call the ambulance.

Using the Heimlich method, apply pressure to the victim's abdomen in

succession to remove the amount of water ingested.
