ECTS grading scale:

<u>ECTS Grade</u>	<u>Romanian Grade</u>	<u>Definition</u>	
<u>A</u>	<u>10</u>	<u>EXCELLENT</u>	<u>outstanding performance with only minor errors</u>
<u>B</u>	<u>9</u>	<u>VERY GOOD</u>	<u>above the average standard but with some errors</u>
<u>C</u>	<u>7-8</u>	<u>GOOD</u>	<u>generally sound work with a number of notable errors</u>
<u>D</u>	<u>6</u>	<u>SATISFACTORY</u>	<u>fair but with significant shortcomings</u>
<u>E</u>	<u>5</u>	<u>SUFFICIENT</u>	<u>performance meets the minimum criteria</u>
<u>F</u>	<u>4-1</u>	<u>FAIL</u>	<u>considerable further work is required</u>
